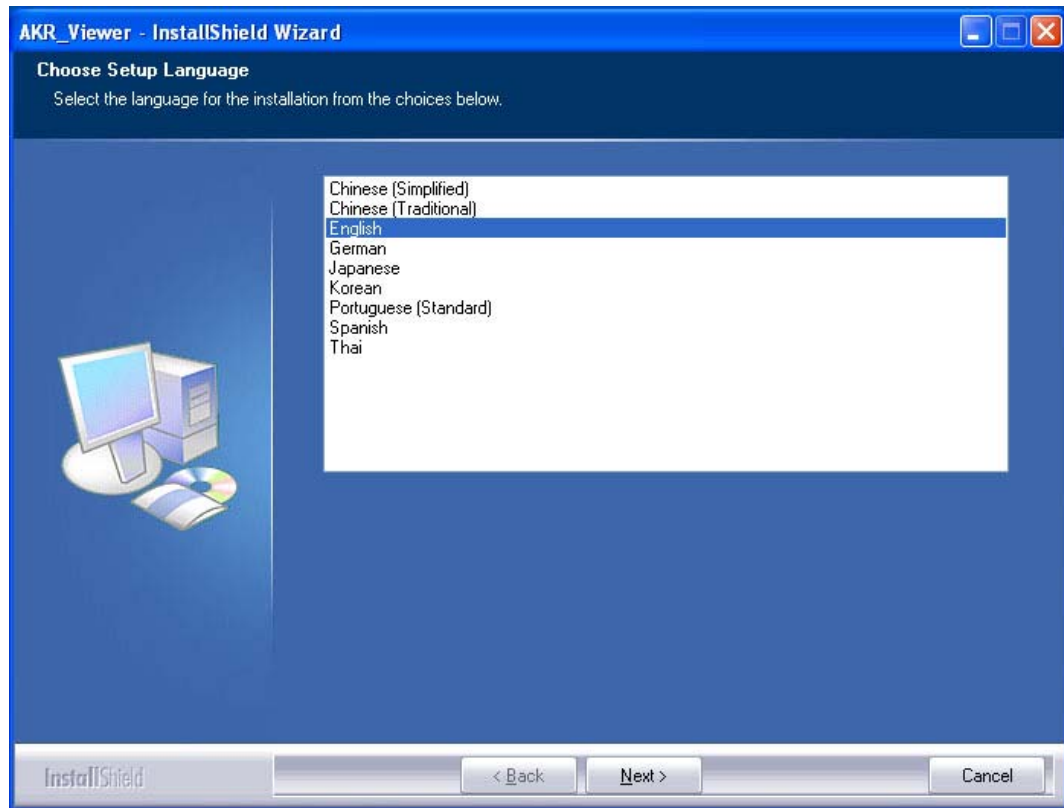

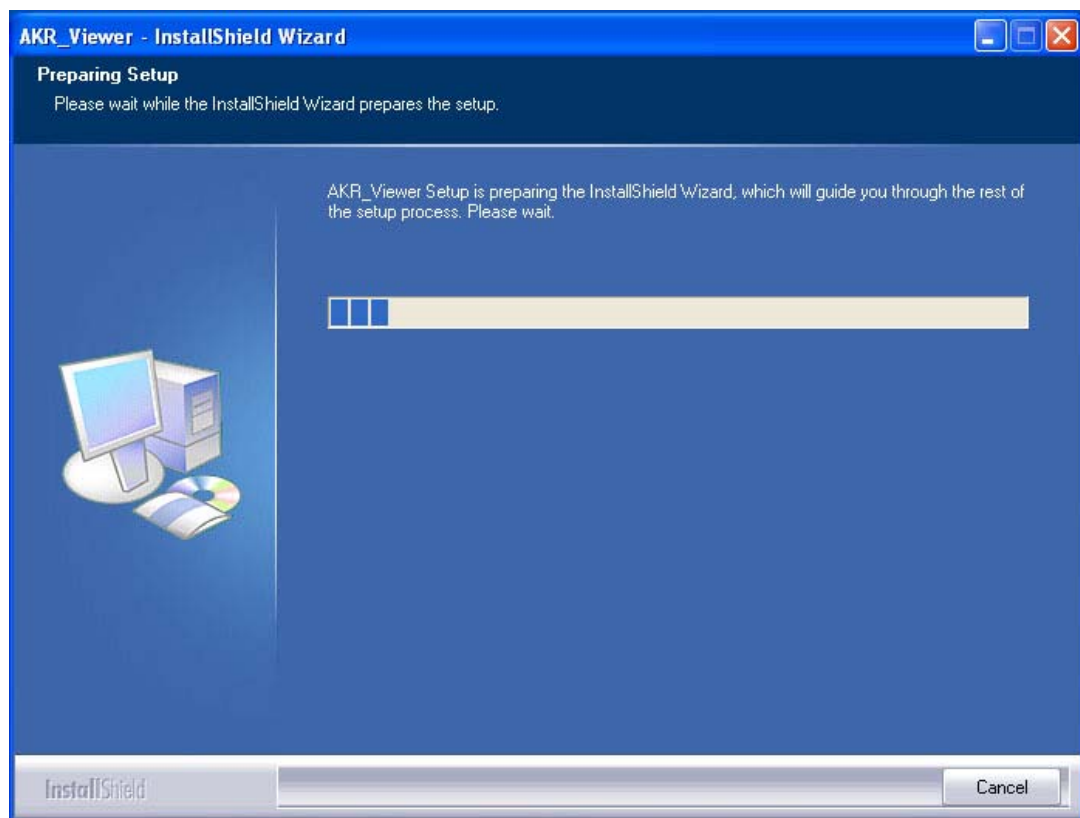

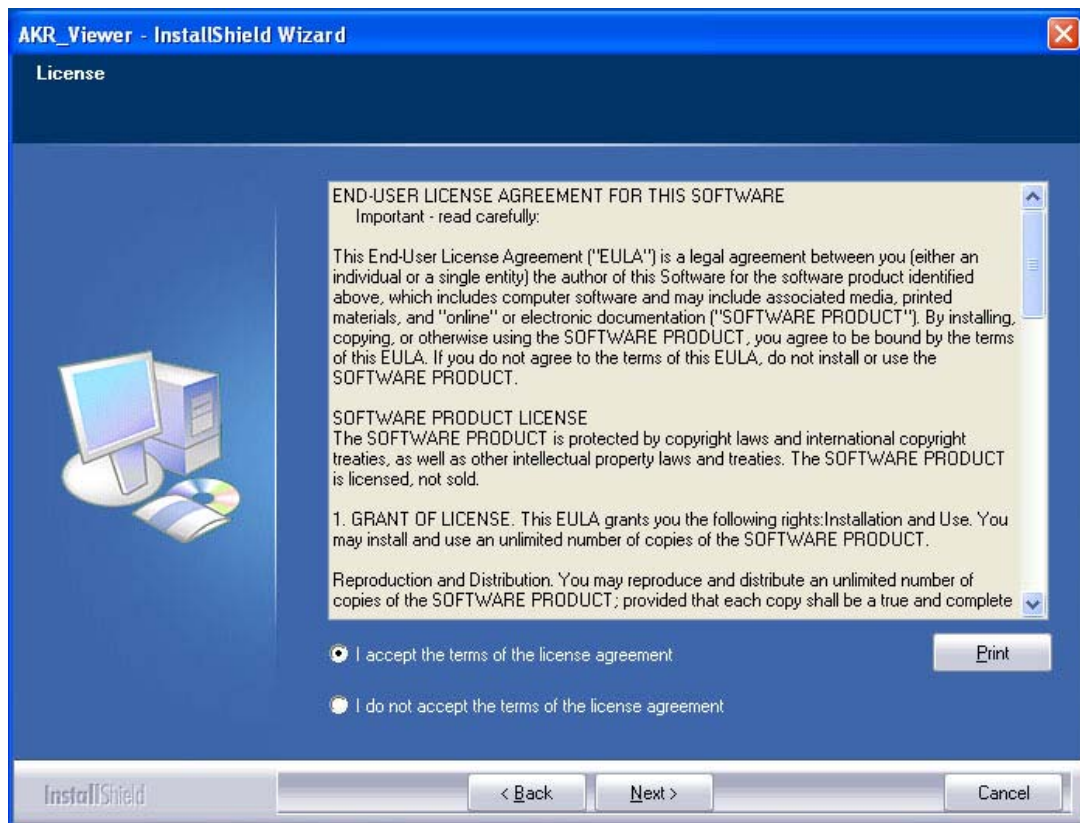
Pic. 3—1 Select language

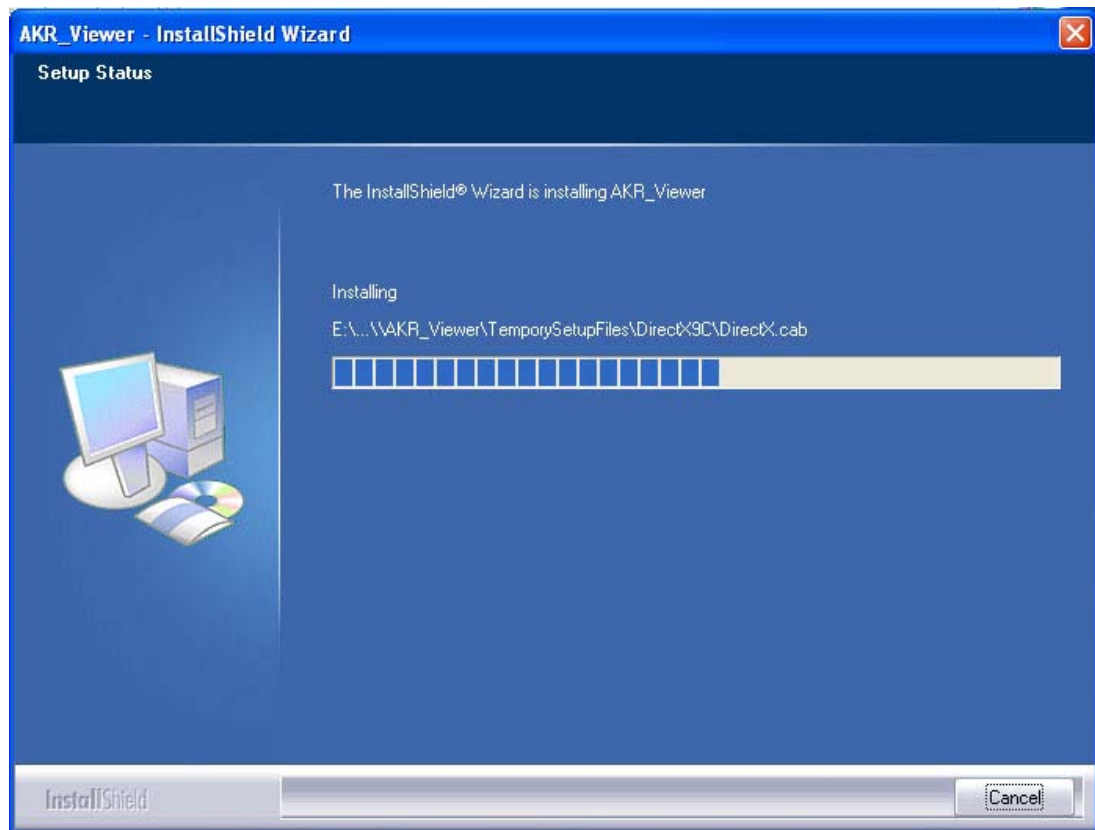


Pic. 3—2 Set up the program

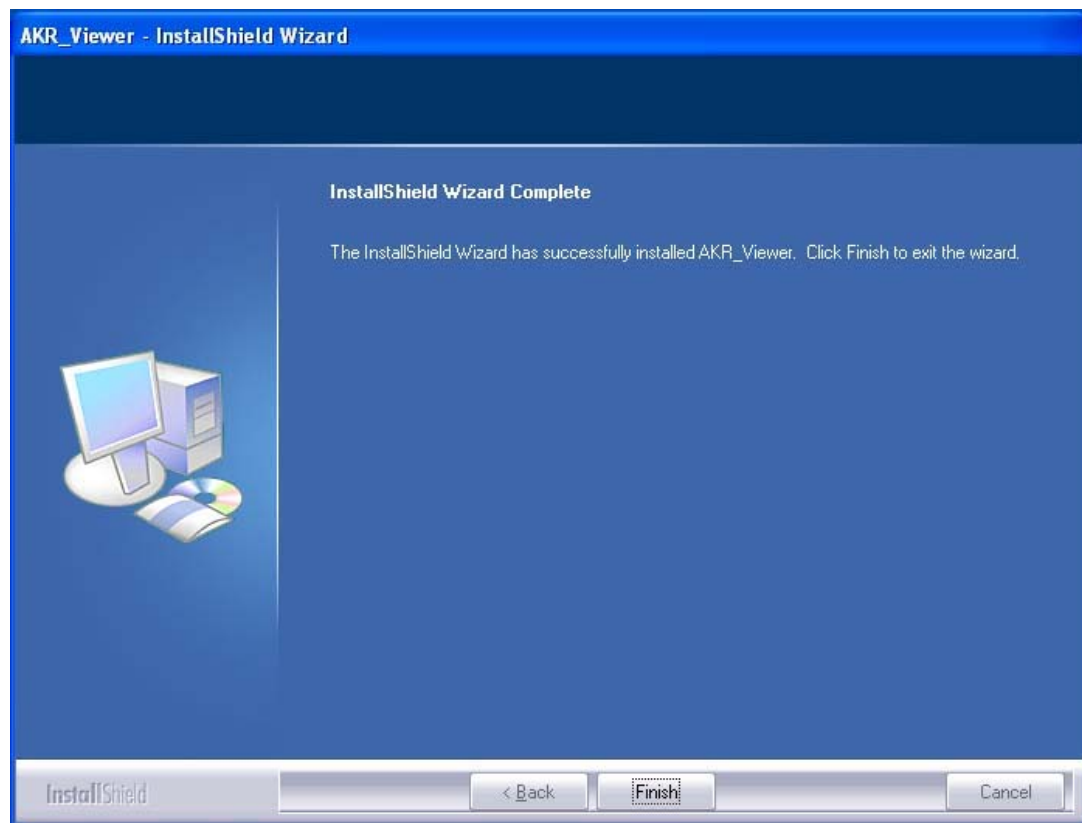

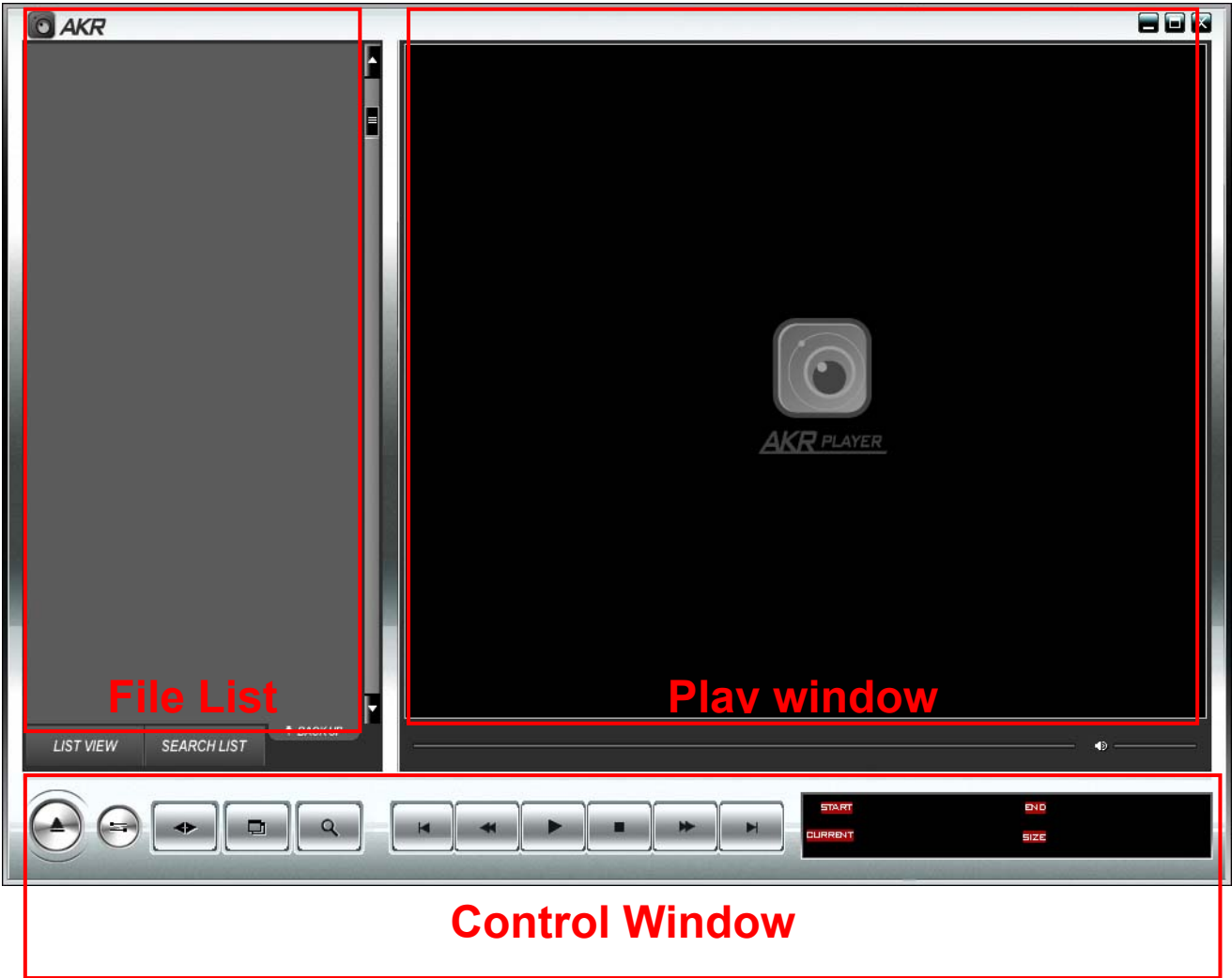

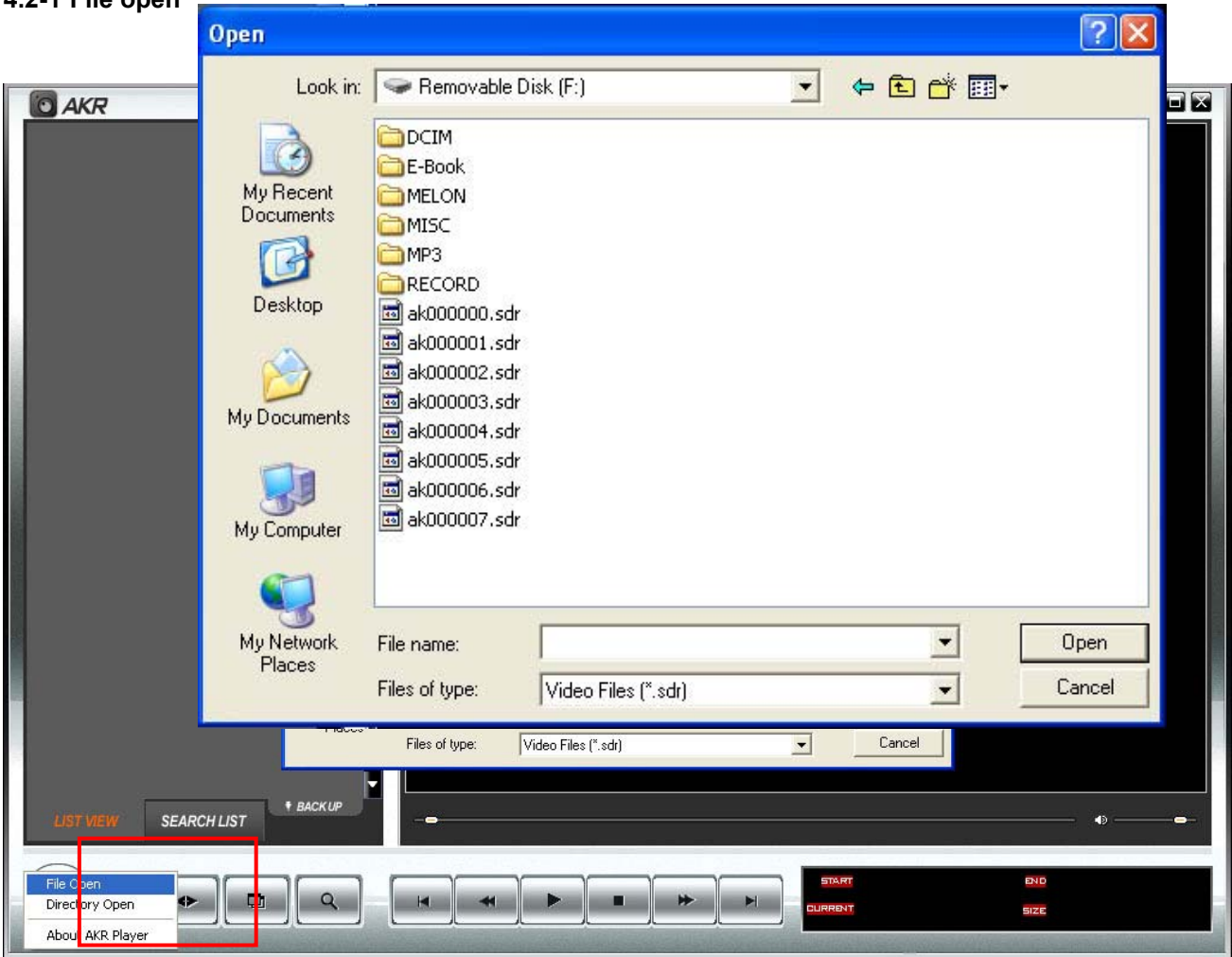

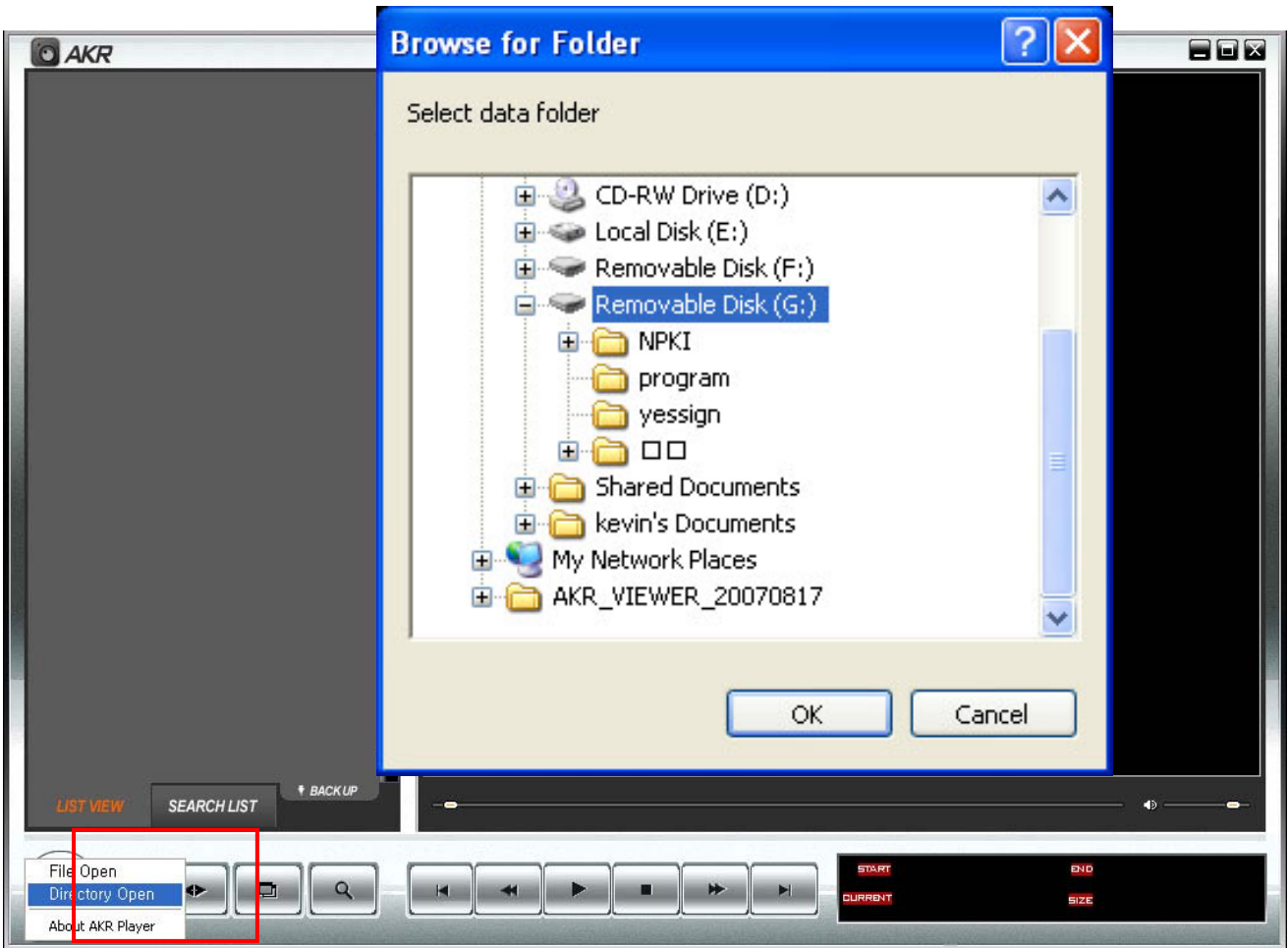

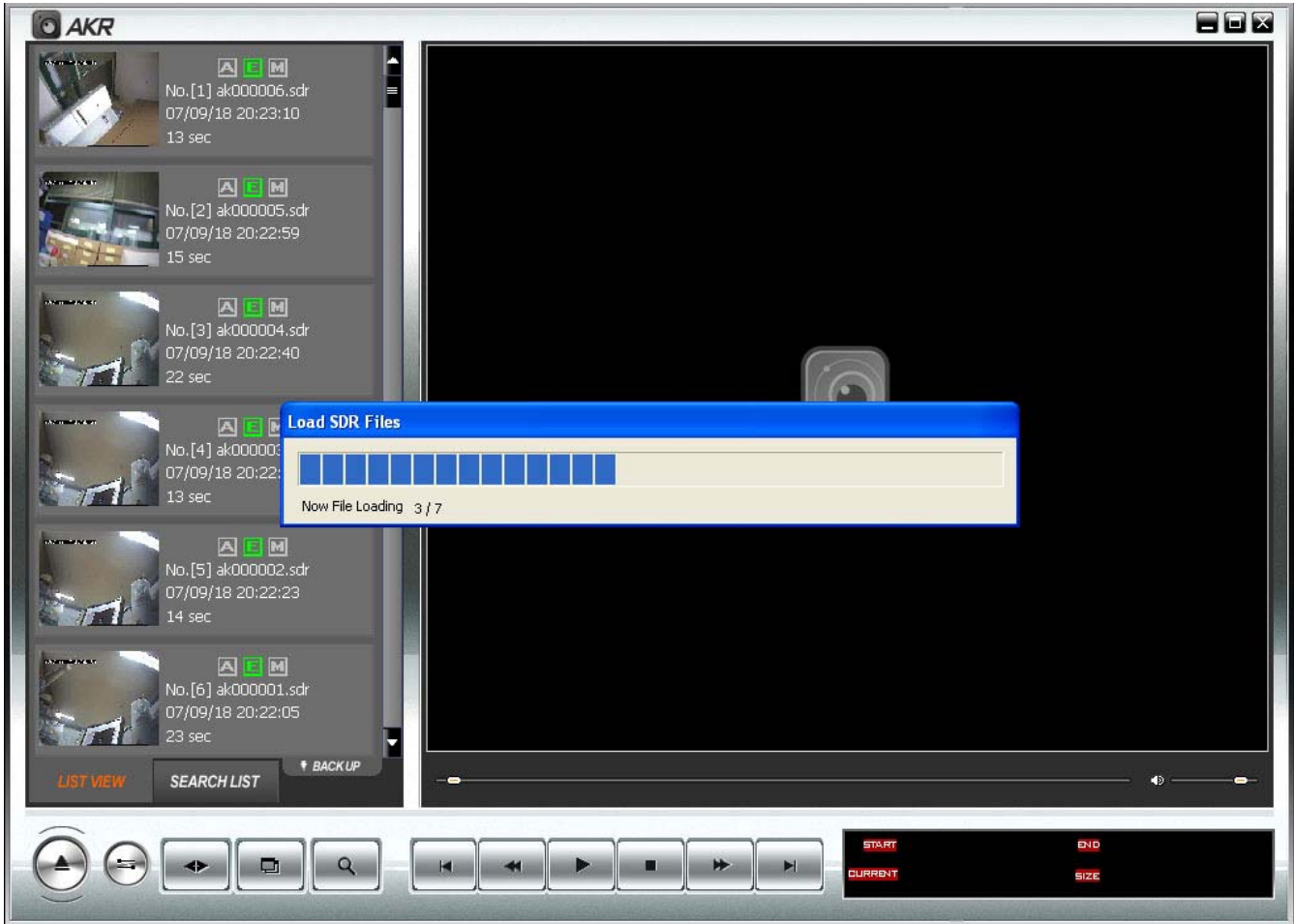

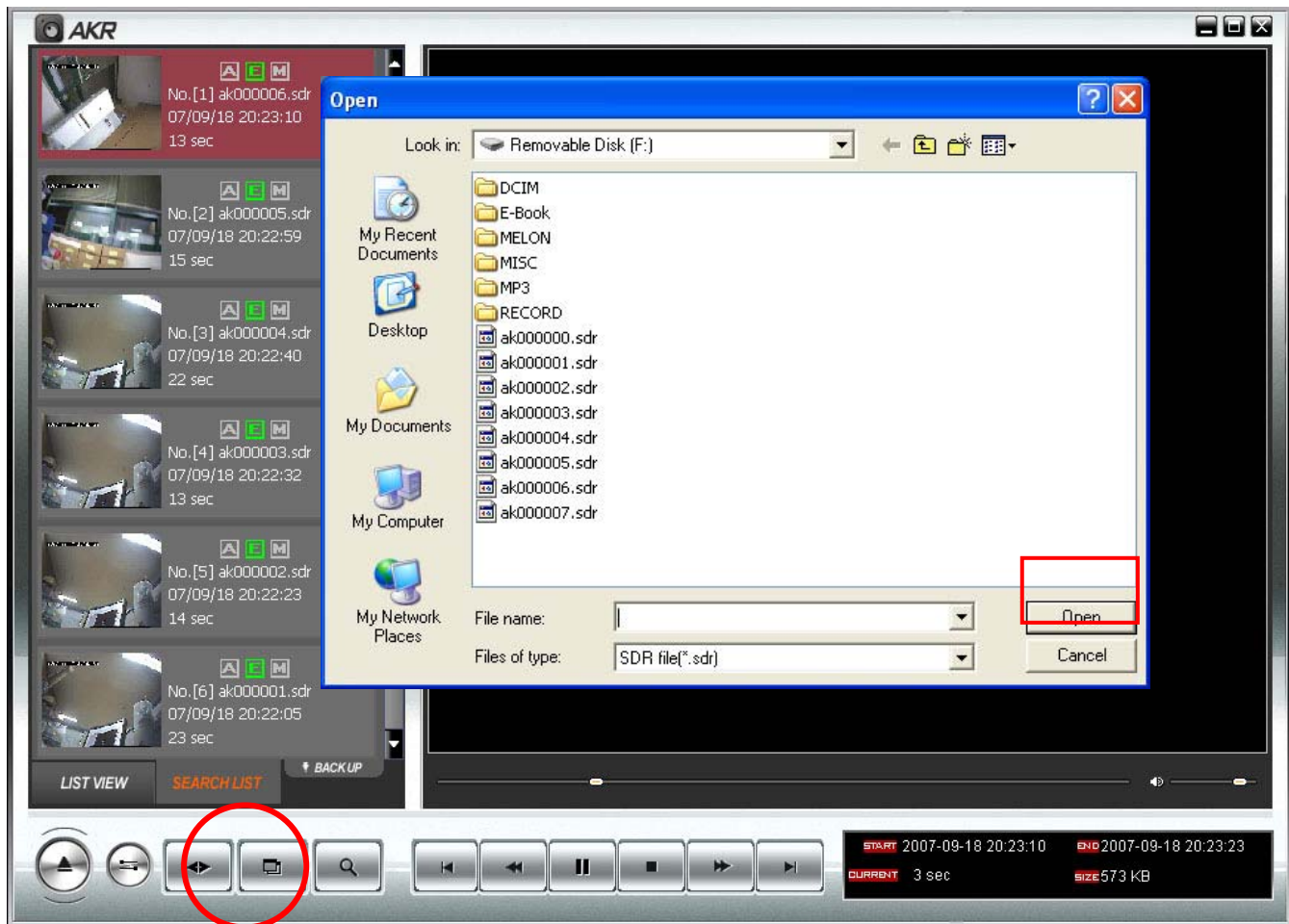

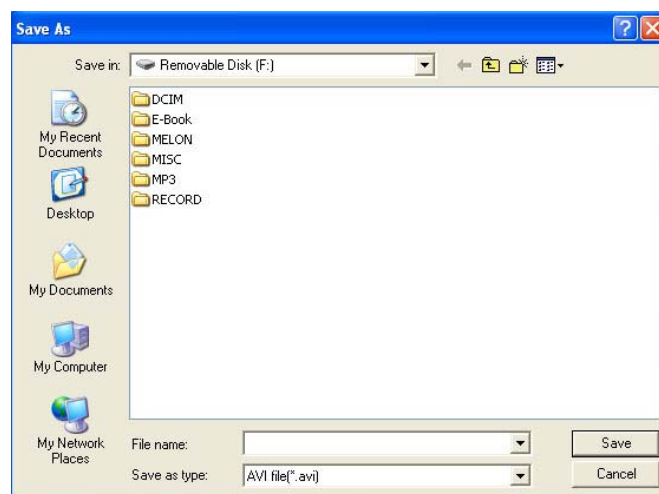


Pic. 4.2-4 SDR File Play

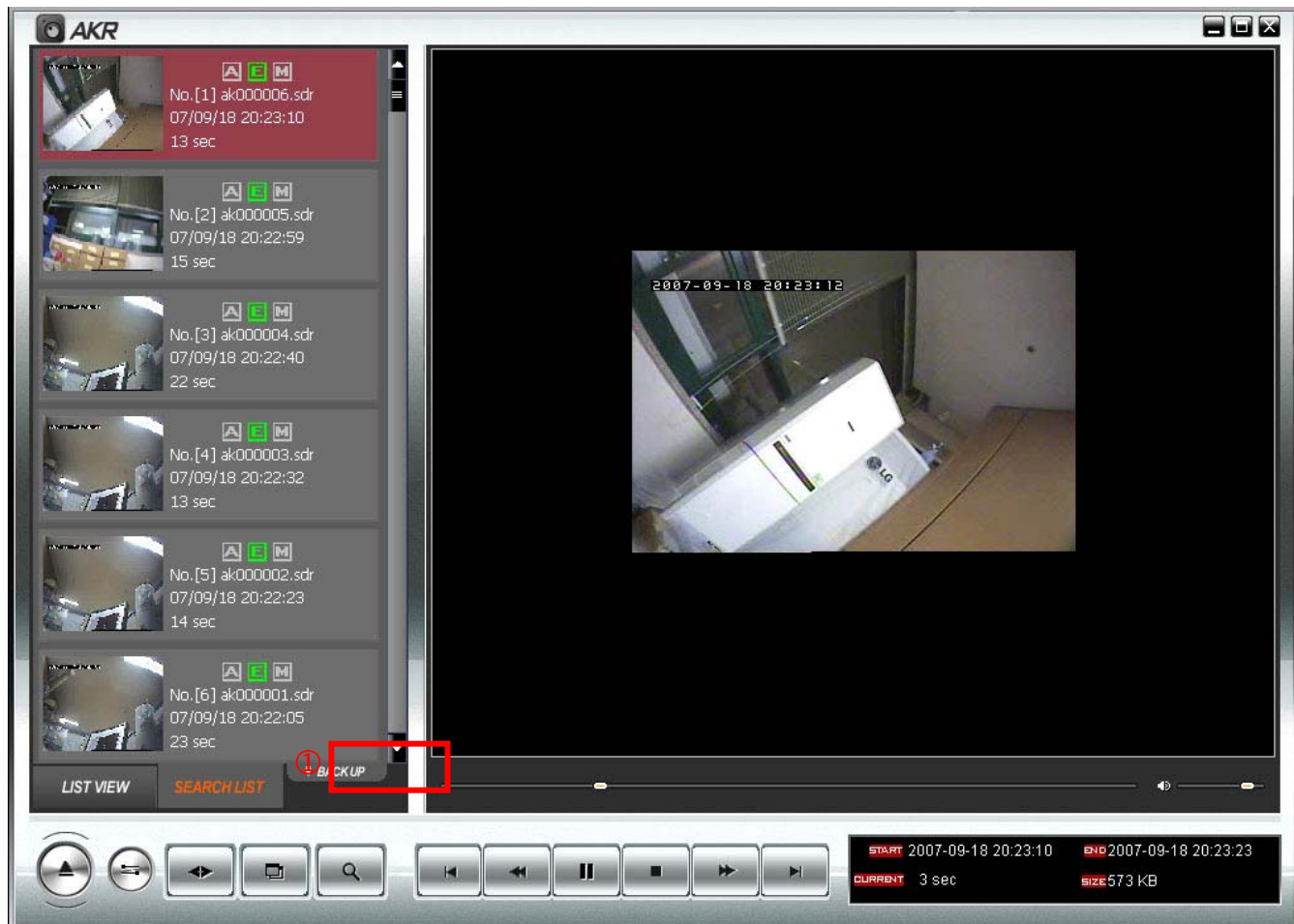


Pic. 4.3-1 Select File to convert to 'AVI' format



Pic. 4.3-2 Save as AVI file name

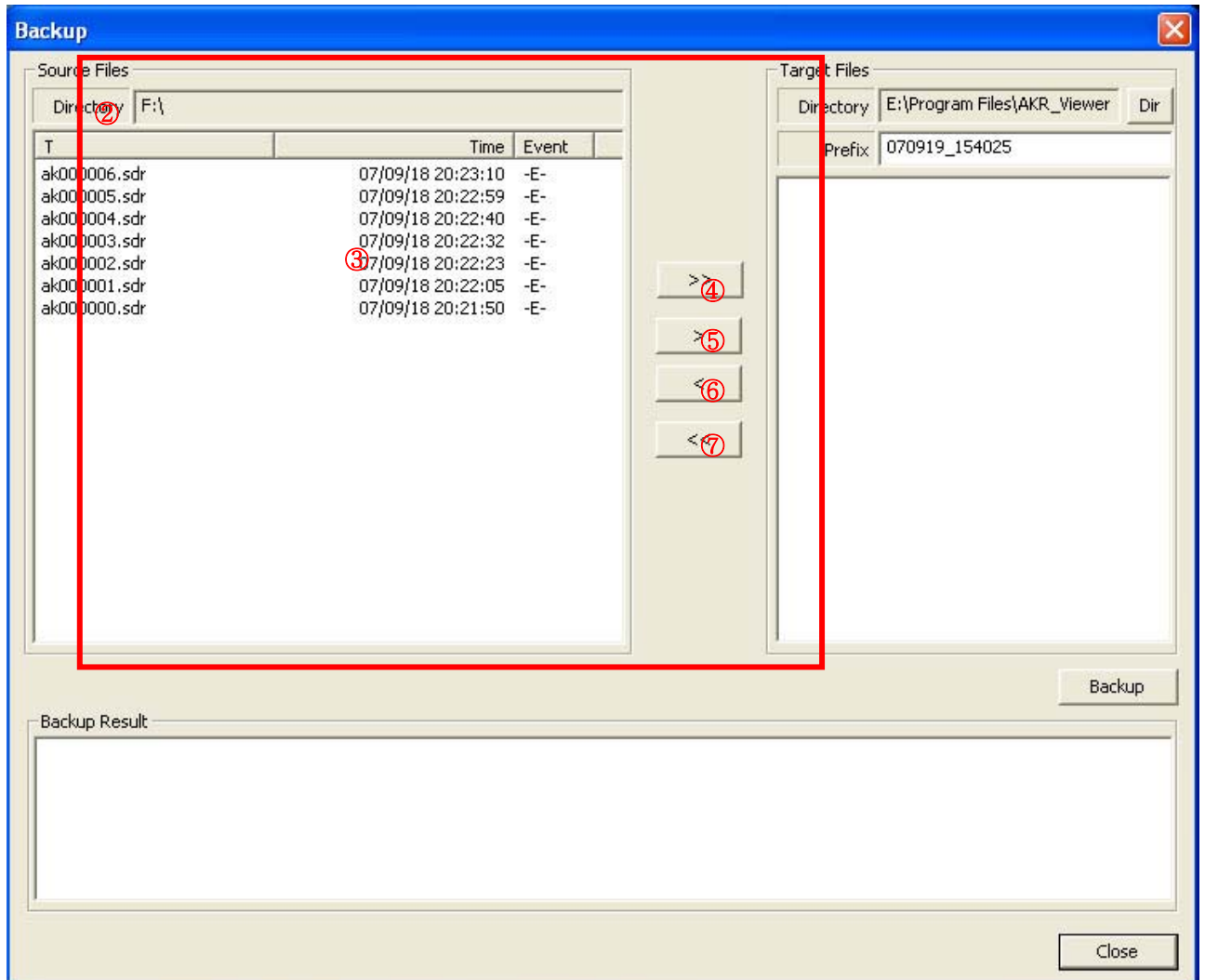
4.4 Backup

- ① Click 'Backup' button to open 'backup tool' as shown in [Pic. 4.7-1].

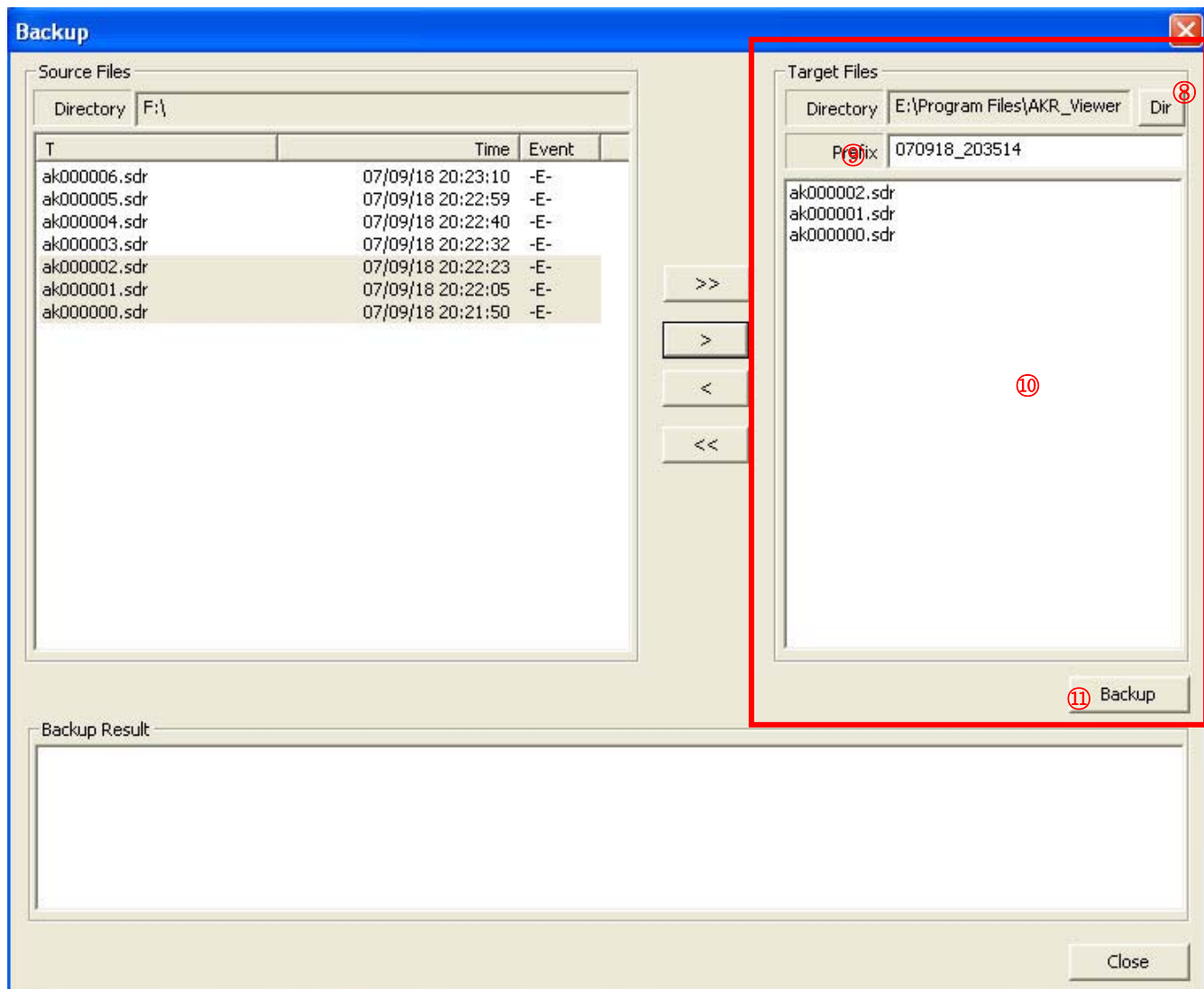
4.4-1 Source Files

- ⑦ Cancel all files in 'Target Files Window'.

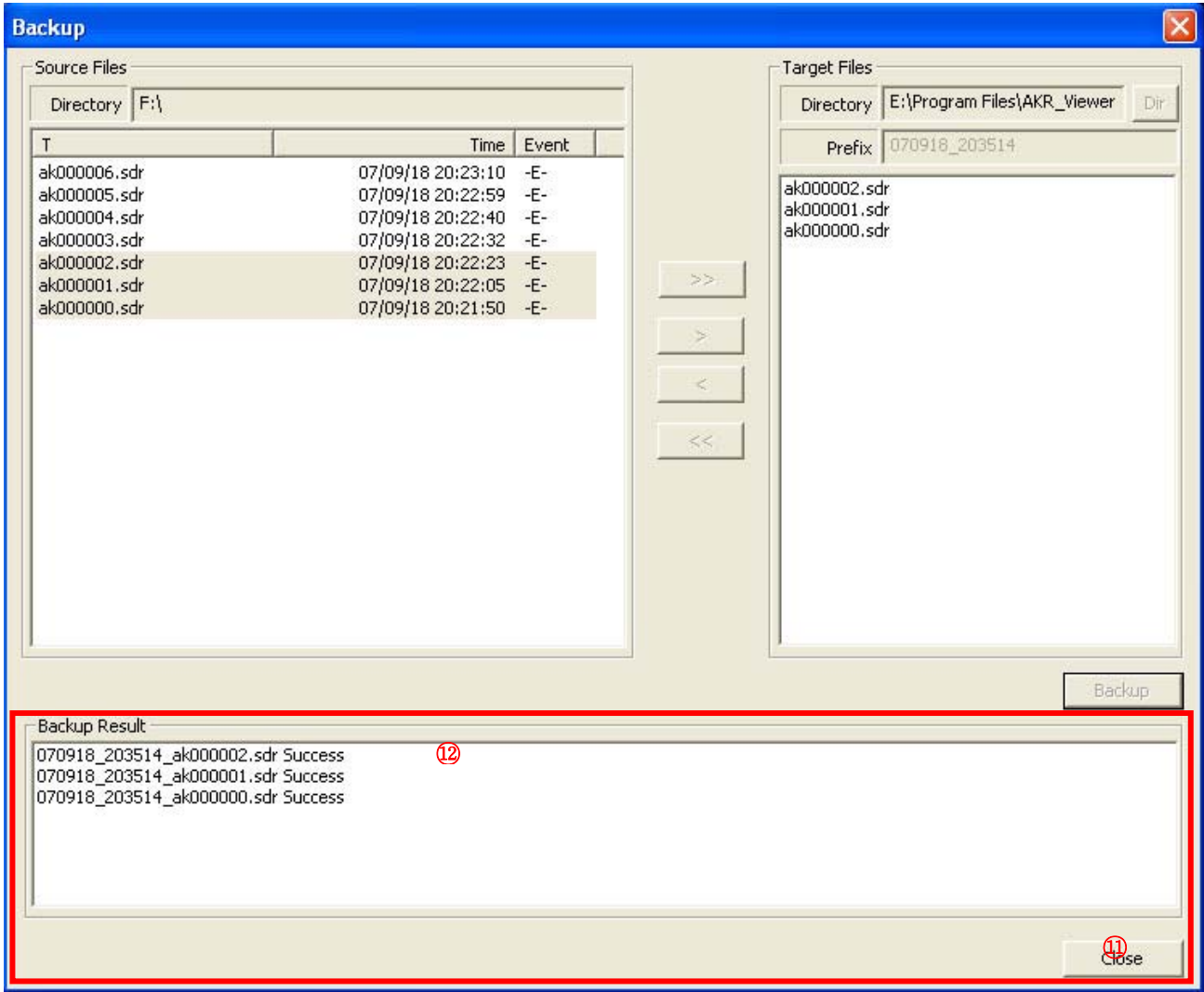
